

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

The following is the scoring system for the various GSDCV Inc. Perpetual Show Trophies that are presented at the Club's AGM each year. The scoring period is from the 1st February each year to the 31st January the following year (except for puppy scores).

SPECIALTY DOG & BITCH OF THE YEAR

Is open to any dog or bitch owned by a GSDCV member, and exhibited in Junior, Intermediate, or Open classes at the GSDCA National Show, State Breed Exhibitions, or any Specialist Championship Shows in Australia where GSDCA medals and gradings are awarded. Separate point score tables will be kept for males and females, in both Stock Coat and Long Stock Coat varieties.

Scores are calculated as follows:

SCHNEIDER TROPHY

Is awarded annually to a dog or bitch of either coat variety, owned by a member of the GSDCV Inc., and registered with Dogs Victoria, that competes in Junior, Intermediate or Open classes at the shows listed above, or at a Victorian All-Breed show where a GSD specialist judge is appointed.

Scores are as for the Specialty Dog Trophy above, with the addition of points for results at:

All Breed shows (with GSD specialist judge) –

ERICH ORSCHLER BREEDER'S TROPHY

Is open to all GSDCV members who have a Breeder's Prefix registered with Dogs Victoria.

* The onus is on the breeder to submit full details of their kennel's results to the Trophy Officer (ian.urie@bigpond.com) by 31st January each year.

MARGOT HAINES PUPPY OF THE YEAR

Is open to Puppies from 3 to 12 months of age owned and exhibited by GSDCV members. Points are scored in a similar manner to the Specialty show Trophy, and puppies may accrue points until they enter Junior class (after which time they will be credited to the adult score tables). Points can be carried over to the next year and the Annual winner will be the puppy with the highest score in any calendar year, with a separate trophy for each sex and coat variety

Point Score tables for the Specialty Trophies, Schneider Trophy, and 'Margot Haines' Puppy of the Year Trophies are listed on the GSDCV website. The Perpetual Trophies will be inscribed with the annual winners' names, and replicas presented to the recipients at the Club AGM.
